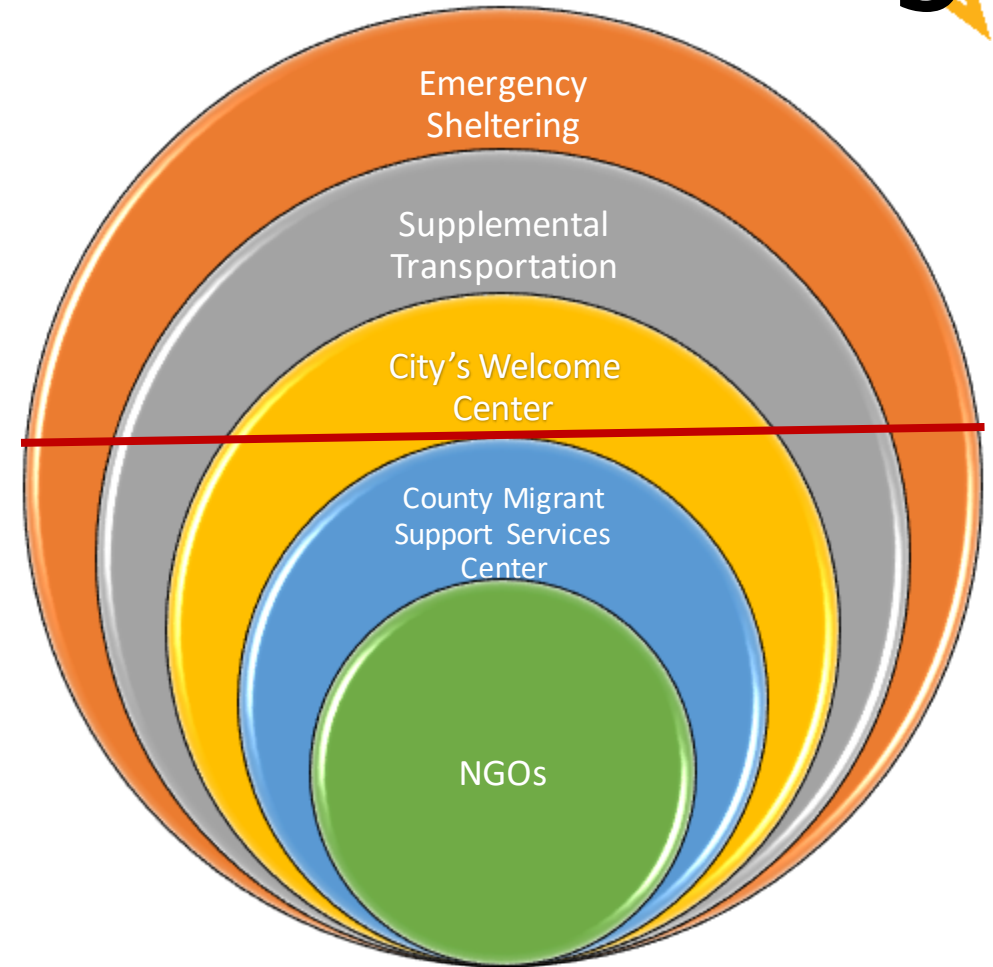

TIMELINE



November 15, 2022

- Judge strikes down Title 42 Pandemic Border Directive
- FED asks to defer ruling effect



December 21, 2022

- Order will go into effect

THE RULING



The court... concludes that the... Order is arbitrary and capricious due to the CDC's failure to acknowledge and explain its departure from past practice


But regardless of the CDC's conclusion, its decision to ignore the harm that could be caused by issuing its Title 42 orders was arbitrary and capricious

CDC did not justify its policy

Defendants have not shown that the risk of migrants spreading COVID-19 is a real problem

The public has a strong interest in "preventing aliens from being wrongfully removed, particularly to countries where they are likely to face substantial harm."


Take-away Information



The Court has ruled that the CDC's use of Title 42 COVID-19 related powers as a means of keeping individuals in Mexico must stop



On December 21, the ruling will officially take effect and permanently halt the Federal Government's use of and reliance on that policy



The Federal Government's ability to enforce immigration law via other means has not been impacted
