MST Program Honored with Excellence Award

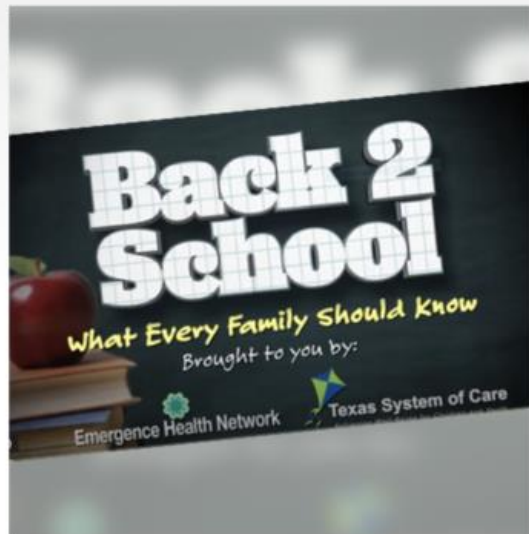

EHN Hosts Back-To-School TV Special

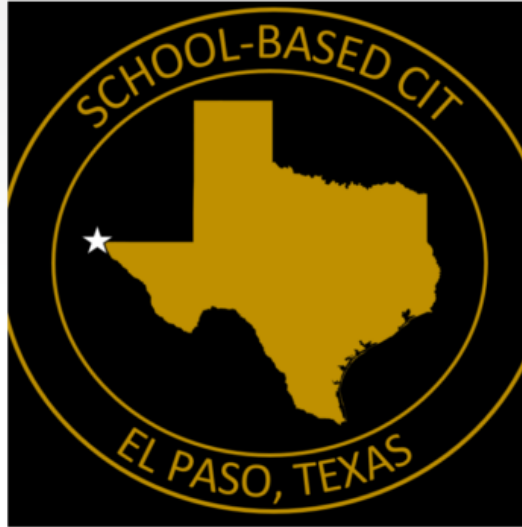

It can be scary when a friend of loved one is thinking about suicide, but recognizing when someone is having suicidal thoughts and feelings can make a difference.

Warning Signs

- Reckless Behavior
- Increasing alcohol or drug use
- Giving away personal belongings
- "Threading to hurt or kill oneself"
- Withdrawing from friends, family or activities
- Feeling hopeless, worthless, trapped or lost of purpose
- Dramatic change in mood
- Previous suicide attempts

EHN Social Media Videos

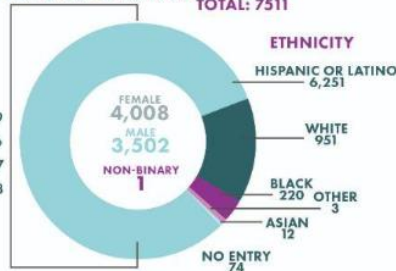

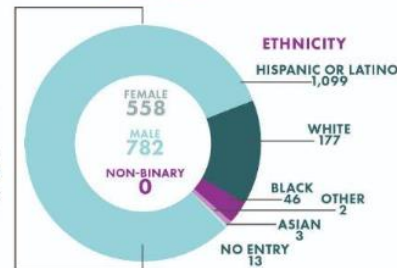

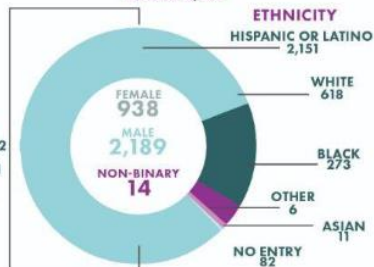
IDD TOTAL: 1,340

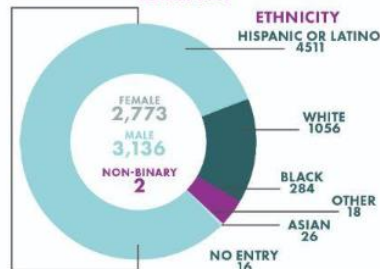
DIVERSION TOTAL: 3,141

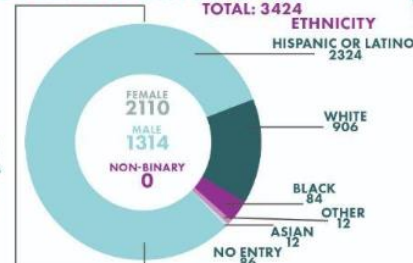
CRISIS AND EMERGENCY TOTAL: 5911

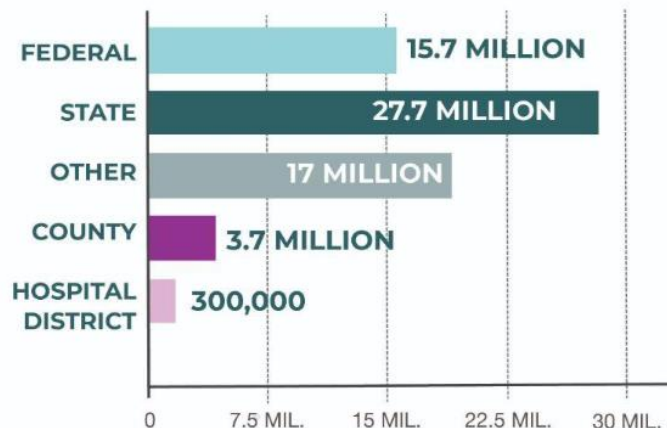
COLLABORATIVE CARE TOTAL: 3,424

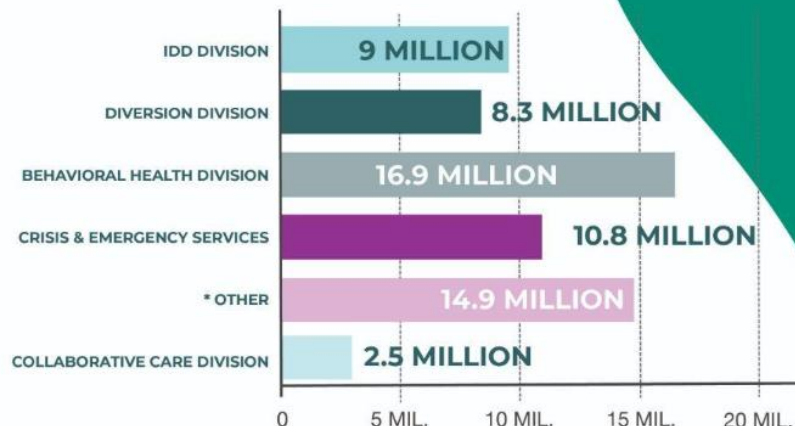
