The item is an amendment to the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Program to remove operation of HMIS project by EPCH, which is the administrator of the local HMIS. This system is utilized by homeless assistance providers to create a more coordinated and effective housing and service delivery system. EPCH funded the activity with other funds, not administered by the City. It is recommended that this project be removed from the 47th Year (2021-2022) ESG program.

WHEREAS, on June 22, 2021, the City Council for the City of El Paso adopted the Annual Action Plan for 2021-2022 and on that date Authorized the City Manager to sign and submit to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) the 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan to include all certifications contained therein; and

WHEREAS, the City of El Paso, Texas has been allocated \$40,000 in Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding for Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) project; and

WHEREAS, on March 14, 2023, the City amended the Annual Action Plan to include the HOME-ARP Allocation Plan ("**First Amendment**"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council, based on the recommendation of the Climate and Sustainability Officer, now desires to amend the 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan to delete the existing project and move funding to another existing project; and

WHEREAS, on February 24, 2023, the City of El Paso posted on its website public notice and allowed a 30-day public comment period regarding the proposed amendment to the Annual Action Plan and 47th year ESG Program Budget and City Council has duly considered public comment if any.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

- 1. That the City of El Paso's 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan is hereby amended as follows:
 - a. Delete HMIS project 40,000, and
 - b. Add an additional \$40,000 to the ESG Emergency Shelter component.
- 2. That the Department of Community and Human Development, through the Director, be authorized to make the above changes to the 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan in the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development's program system.
- 3. That, except as amended herein and in the First Amendment, the 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan remains in full force and effect.
- 4. That the City Manager, or designee, be authorized to take any actions necessary to accomplish the intent of this resolution.
