FAB LAB: Strengthening Local Innovation Ecosystems through New-Collar Workforce

Provide mentorship and hands-on skills training to pave the way for digital fabrication while subsidizing living costs.

- Two-year pilot program, \$2,500 stipend per semester
 + \$2,870 to provide equipment, licensing, software
 and training per student
- Upon graduation will receive Master 3D Printing Certification
- Program will serve 25 high school seniors from Ysleta Independent School District (YISD)

BitWise Impact: Leading Digital Transformation for the Future

Closing the gap between the marginalized community and technical education.

- 6-week Pre-apprenticeship program coding, website development, JavaScript and React Web
- 1 year Apprentice program hired as employees to gain at a minimum of \$15 per hour
- Creation of 100 websites for local small businesses
- Guaranteed job placement for 12 apprenticeship graduates into local tech companies.

Success Through Technology Education (STTE): Advance Startups into stand-alone companies that generate revenue

Working to create an innovative environment that nurtures entrepreneurs and creative problem solvers.

Four-year program, three phase journey:

- Phase 1: Outreach & Engagement
- Phase 2: Product-market fit
- Phase 3: Funding
- Collaborate in entrepreneurial ecosystem, receive mentorship, support for business plan development, financial concepts training, investor pitch deck preparation, legal services, have access to co-working space.
- Participate in startup sprints, pitch events.
- Program will serve 20 local startups

JUST: Trust Based Lending + Technical Assistance for Female Entrepreneurs

Build financial resilience of participants and strengthen small businesses for female entrepreneurs based on a **unique trust-based lending model**

Multi-layered approach **Technical Assistance**:

- Train and support client leaders (Peer Coaching)
- Periodic visits, remote and in-person
- Digital platform (Fundamentals and finance management)

Female entrepreneurs complete 5-week program

- In-person and virtual sessions
- Build skills in financial management and leadership
- Program will serve 150 female entrepreneurs

UTEP Hunt Institute: Data Compilation and Economic Impact Analysis

- Compile data on local and state business hub projects to create metrics needed to measure the performance of the business one-stop shop.
- Design bilingual (English/Spanish) entry and exit surveys for counseling sessions conducted by the business onestop shop, measure the performance of businesses that seek assistance as well as the one stop-shop's impact on the region.
- Create fact sheets, dashboards, recovery assessment reports, and maps.
- **Develop** business intelligence reports, market assessments and data visualizations.
- Conduct economic impact analysis to assess impact of business one-stop-shop in regional economy.
