## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on June 22, 2021, the City Council for the City of El Paso adopted the Annual Action Plan for 2021-2022 and on that date Authorized the City Manager to sign and submit to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) the 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan to include all certifications contained therein; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of El Paso, Texas has been allocated \$40,000 in Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funding for Homeless Management Information System (HMIS) project; and

WHEREAS, on March 14, 2023, the City amended the Annual Action Plan to include the HOME-ARP Allocation Plan ("First Amendment"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council, based on the recommendation of the Climate and Sustainability Officer, now desires to amend the 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan to delete the existing project and move funding to another existing project; and

WHEREAS, on February 24, 2023, the City of El Paso posted on its website public notice and allowed a 30-day public comment period regarding the proposed amendment to the Annual Action Plan and 47<sup>th</sup> year ESG Program Budget and City Council has duly considered public comment if any.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EL PASO:

- 1. That the City of El Paso's 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan is hereby amended as follows:
  - a. Delete HMIS project 40,000, and
  - b. Add an additional \$40,000 to the ESG Emergency Shelter component.
- That the Department of Community and Human Development, through the Director, be authorized to make the above changes to the 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan in the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development's program system.
- 3. That, except as amended herein and in the First Amendment, the 2021-2022 Annual Action Plan remains in full force and effect.
- 4. That the City Manager, or designee, be authorized to take any actions necessary to accomplish the intent of this resolution.
