#### **BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION:**

The easement is needed for use of approximately 5.739 acres of land for the operation of a radio tower and adjacent equipment building at Fort Bliss Military Reservation. The 300-foot tower is part of the radio communications system for the City of El Paso's public safety departments.
