The City hosts senior fitness programs at its various recreation centers, which senior residents frequent and enjoy. There is an associated cost to participate in a program. Currently, insurance and other prominent senior fitness programs, like Silver Sneakers are not offered at City facilities, nor are calendar period enrollment, such as monthly or yearly memberships. Many seniors rely on the exercise and facilities provided by the City for physical and mental well-being but many are also on a fixed income and/or on Medicare.

Medicare, a United States federal health insurance program
designed to provide and reduce the cost of healthcare services for
those who are Medicare-eligible.

- Individuals are eligible for Medicare if they meet one of the following criteria:
 - You're aged 65 or older.
 - You're younger than 65 with eligible disabilities by the Social Security Administration.
 - You have End-Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) or Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS).

El Paso County Statistics on Medicare


There are 140,556 Medicare-eligible people living in El Paso County, Texas.


What is Silver and Fit?


