FY23 DCIP GRANT PROGRAM

- Defense Community Infrastructure Pilot (DCIP) Annual application opportunities
 - \$100 million appropriated for FY23
 - Administered by Department of Defense
- FY23 Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) released April 13, 2023
- June 23, 2023 deadline for submission
- Awards announced in September 2023








Fort Bliss Coordination

- Commanding General briefed on project: letter of support requested







Project Demand


- 15,000 service members separate from the service from Fort Bliss each year
- 3,000 per year currently make El Paso their permanent home
- This is a highly trained workforce and unique competitive advantage







- Build Back Better: Fort Bliss technical talent can support advanced manufacturing and aerospace industry

- Increased military value through improved efficiency, enhanced readiness, and increased retention




