University Medical Center of El Paso is the largest public hospital located directly on the U.S. Mexico border. Its mission since opening in 1915 has been to enhance the health and wellness of the El Paso community by making high quality, affordable health care services available to all.

Accredited by The Joint Commission, University Medical Center of El Paso is a 394-bed licensed acute care facility and the only public teaching hospital in El Paso. Texas Tech University Medical School designated University Medical Center of El Paso as its primary teaching facility in 1973. University Medical Center of El Paso was officially designated as El Paso's Trauma Center in 1986, and has since earned state designation as a Level I Trauma Center, one of only five in Texas. University Medical Center of El Paso serves as the only comprehensive civilian Trauma Center within a 250-mile radius of El Paso.

Maria Mercedes Zampini is a native El Pasoan. She completed both her Bachelors in Business Administration and Masters in Business Administration at the University of Texas at El Paso. She is proud to say that the high quality education she received at the University of Texas at El Paso has afforded her the opportunity to stay in El Paso and give back to the community in which she grew up. Being able to have a personal impact on the delivery of healthcare in the El Paso Community has always been a professional goal; the first step was a solid foundation accomplished through her experience at UTEP.

Maria joined the University Medical Center team over twenty years ago. She currently holds the position of Chief Operating Officer. As Chief Operating Officer for the University Medical Center she is responsible for all facility renovation and construction projects, real estate acquisitions and transactions, Neighborhood Health Clinic operations, Ancillary (Rehabilitative Services, Pharmacy, Imaging, Regional Laboratory, Respiratory), Perioperative Services and Cath Labs, as well as the Support (Facilities and Maintenance, Environmental Services, Guest Services/Security, Safety, Food Services) Departments. She has completed over \$500M in construction projects over the past ten years as well as opened many new center sites.
