- This is an Advanced Funding Agreement with TxDOT for the design and construction of the Ysleta Middle School Safe Route To School project.
- This project was one of 12 projects selected statewide out of 397 applications for TxDOT's 2019 call for projects for Safe Routes to Schools funding.
- The Ysleta Middle School SRTS project consists of installation of school zone flashers along Independence Drive, ADA ramps at multiple locations, and school zone signs will be upgraded to meet MUTCD standards at Ysleta Middle School. Bicycle lanes will be installed at Elvin Way between Alameda Avenue and Victor Lane. There will also be a hike & bike trail along Playa Lateral between Elvin Way and Jesuit Drive.



Recommendations



- That the City Manager be authorized to sign an Advance Funding Agreement by and between the City of El Paso and the State of Texas, acting by and through the Texas Department of Transportation, for the Ysleta Middle School SRTS project.
- Estimated total project cost: \$1,030,245
- Estimated City participation amount of \$0
