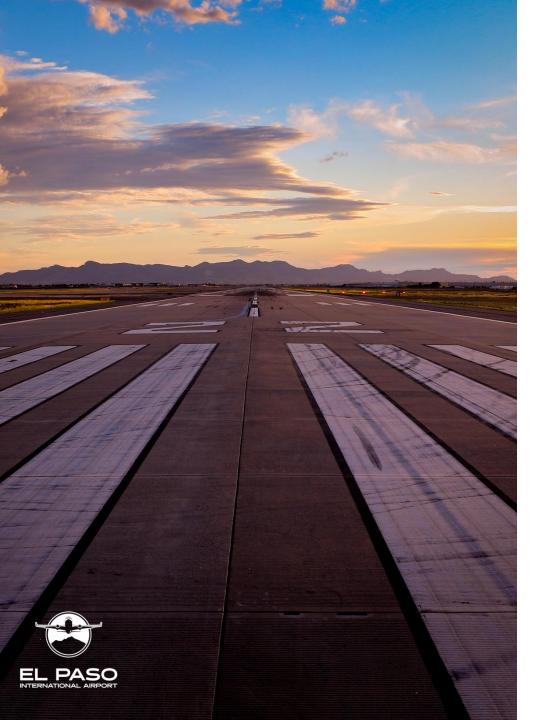

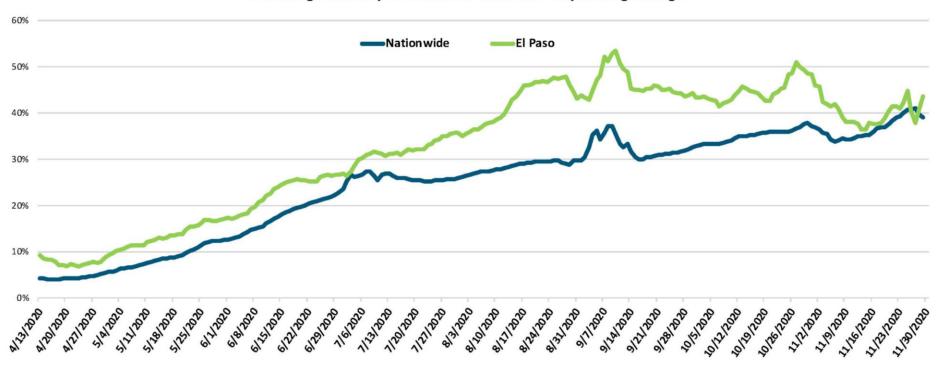

Percentage Recovery of 2019 levels based on 7-Day Moving Average

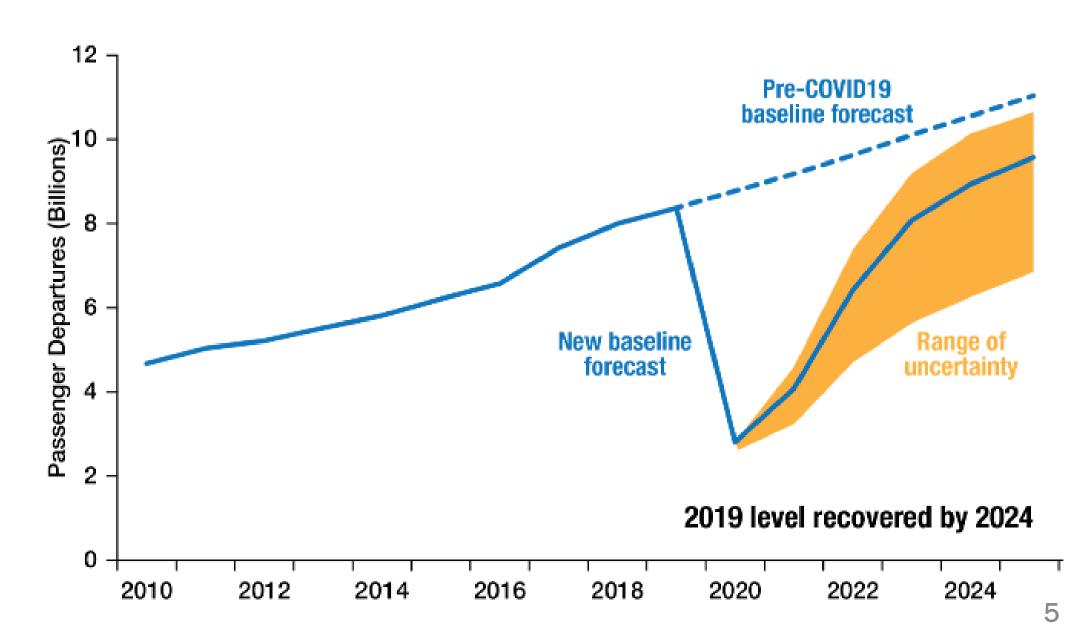

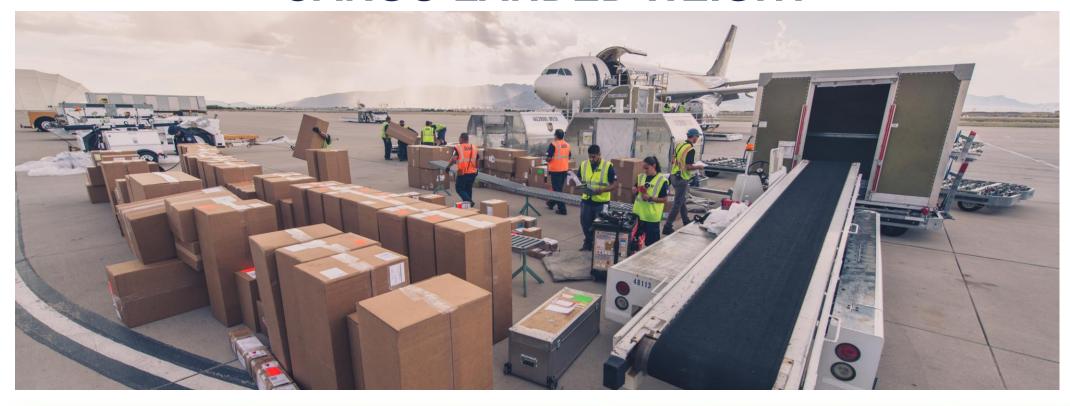

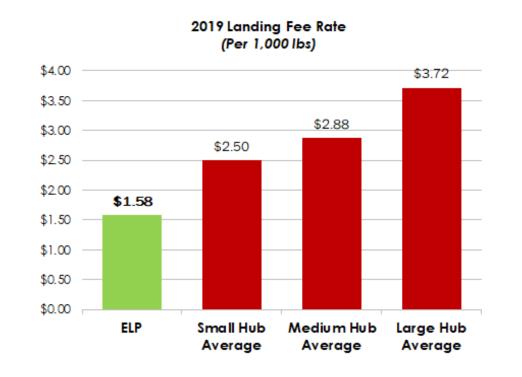


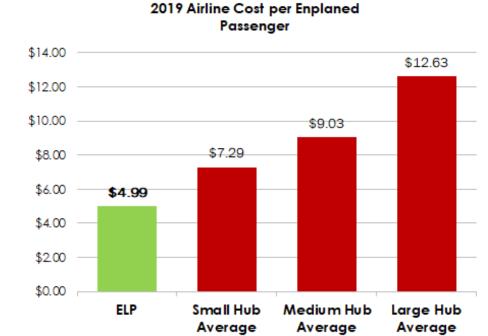
NON-AERONAUTICAL REVENUE FY20

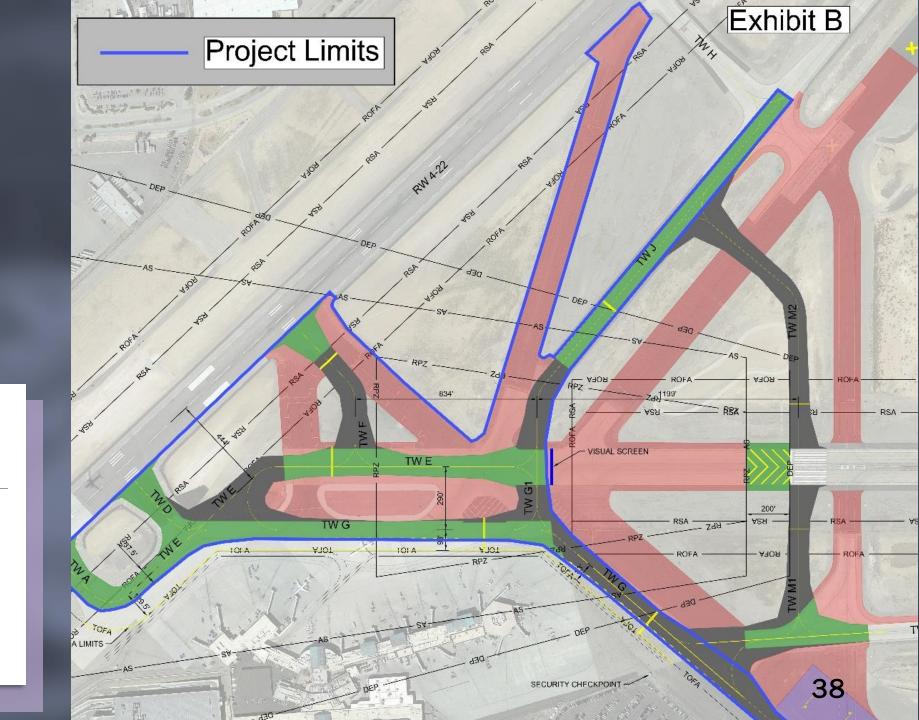




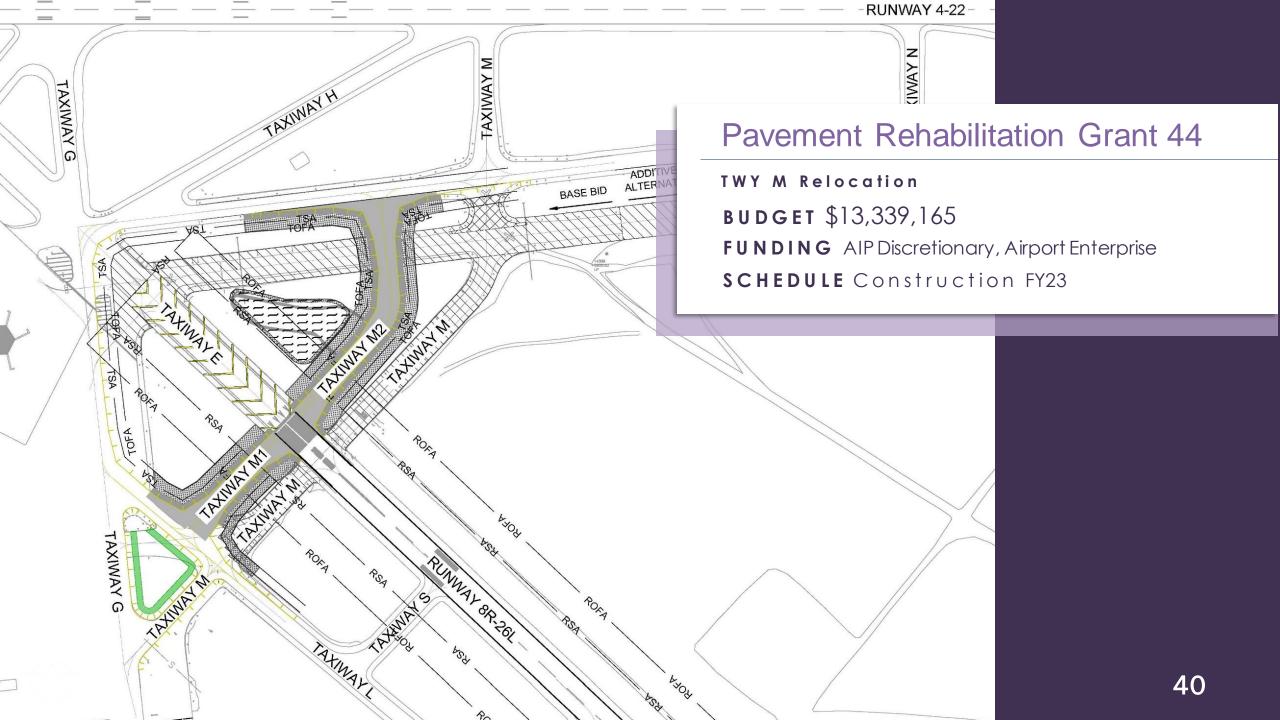


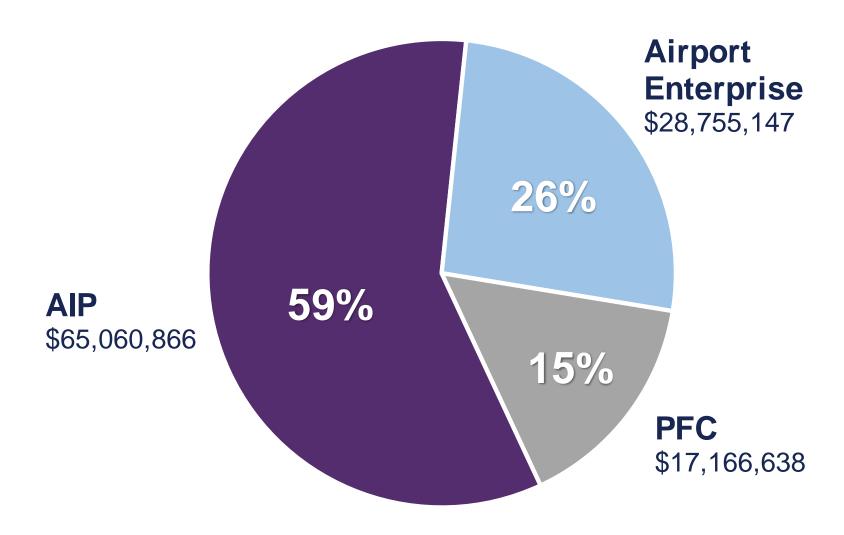
5-Node Intersection Remediation

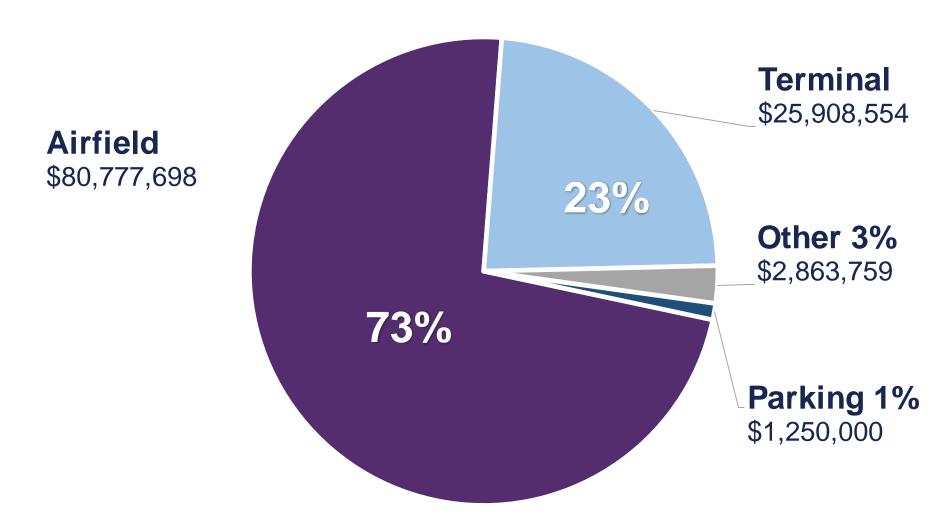








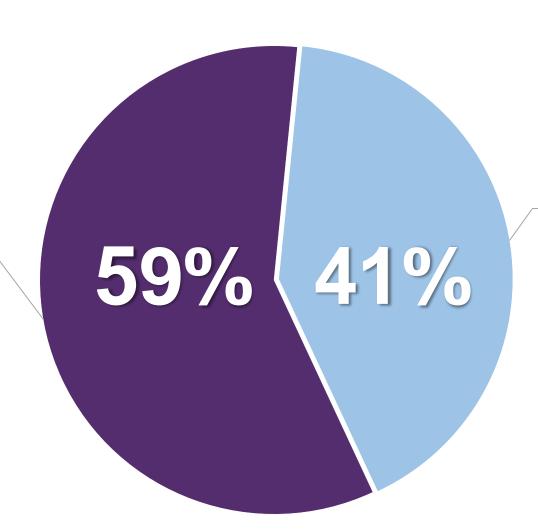

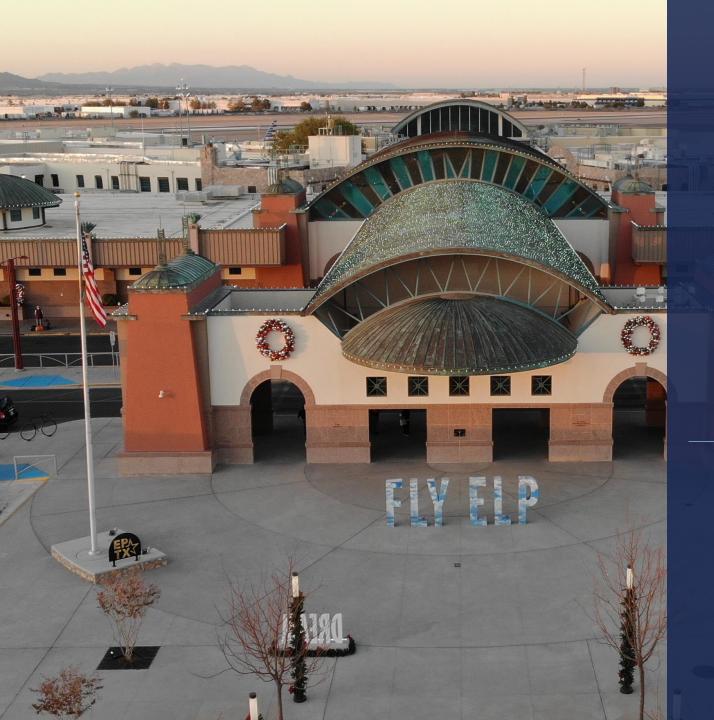
