Project Background

- This is an Advanced Funding Agreement with TxDOT for the Loop 375 Wrong Way Driver Technologies installation.
- The Loop 375 Wrong Way Driver Technologies project consists of the design and construction of improvements along Loop 375 in El Paso's downtown area from San Marcial St. to Santa Fe St. This includes the installation of wrong way detection systems, reconfiguration of exit ramps for Oregon Street and Campbell Street, as well as raised medians and striping on Oregon Street.

- That the City Manager be authorized to sign an Advance Funding Agreement by and between the City of El Paso and the State of Texas, acting by and through the Texas Department of Transportation, for the Loop 375 Wrong Way Driver Technologies project
