Title 21 Amendment 1: 21.50.060.B.1a (Building Disposition)

"Only one building in excess of 200 feet [in width] shall be permitted in a single pedestrian shed*. The width may be adjusted by warrant up to 10%."

*pedestrian sheds have a 1/4 mile radius





21.50.060.B.1a (Building Disposition)

Proposed Amendment

- Remove regulation
- Only effects T4-O and T-6
- Allows more flexibility in development for higher transect zones
- Other regulations for pedestrian access, screening, shade, and landscaping remain

Title 21 Amendment 2: 21.50.060.B4 (Building Disposition)

"One principal building at the frontage, and one outbuilding to the rear of the principal building, may be built on each lot as shown in Table 17c."


•Apply regulation to T-3 and T-4 transects only

•Allow increased development flexibility for transect permitting high-intensity commercial uses


