








Project Timeline



Task	Description
1	Review & recommend revisions in the overall development and process of the ISIP
2	Acquire relevant traffic collision data from TxDOT's CRIS & from City
3	Analyze CRIS data by organizing records by intersections; types of collisions; type of user; severity; & collision contributing factors
4	Identify the intersections with highest risks of traffic collisions by fatality rate; collision rate; & collision frequency
5	For each high-risk intersection, develop short- term & long-term countermeasures; create conceptual renderings of the modifications; & determine preliminary cost estimates
6	Produce & deliver written Project Report
