BACKGROUND / DISCUSSION: Cities of Service is a national nonprofit organization that supports mayors and city chief executives to engage local community and residents to tackle issues and solve problems together using impact volunteering. The Cities of Service organization provides technical assistance, programmatic support, planning resources, and funding opportunities to drive long-term, positive outcomes that help to improve the quality of life in cities. There is no cost to join and the level of engagement is at the discretion of the City—signing the Declaration of Service is a good-faith commitment to support service and volunteerism in our community.
This request is for the Mayor to sign the Declaration of Service, which would have the following benefits: 1) Membership in the Cities of Service Coalition; 2) Eligibility to apply for certain service and volunteerism grants and opportunities, and 3) the City of El Paso would receive training, programmatic support, print and online resources, and recognition. In September of 2021, El Paso was named one of eight cities for the Love Your Block grant which is a two year grant to support resident led efforts to address blight.
