



CDC – Why Vaccinate?

- Can keep you from getting sick with flu
- Shown to reduce the severity of illness in people who get vaccinated but still get sick
- -Can reduce the risk of flu-associated hospitalization
- -An important preventive tool for people with certain chronic health conditions
- Helps protect pregnant people during and after pregnancy
- -May also protect people around you
- -Reduces the overall burden on our community's health care system by allowing system to tend to possible uptick in COVID related illness or other illness.
